Whenever you need a complete reference of American Law Reports (ALR), areas of AMJUR, Causes of Action and Restatements of the law – as well as several other secondary treatise, handbooks and instructions – this combined library will prove invaluable. What's more, it also includes many of the latest national and state law reviews.

For the attorney, this library helps to quickly sort out the factual and legal issues of their case so they can easily define them for their client and the court. The All AMJUR Library, and the All AMJUR Library with ALR, is a group of databases that work together to facilitate faster, more productive research.

The AMJUR Library with ALR includes:

- All of the AMJUR databases
- ALR – a collection of annotations or articles that collect, organise and evaluate all case law relevant to a specific point of law or fact situation. ALR articles look at both sides of an issue so attorneys are better prepared.

The AMJUR database – contains the full text of American Jurisprudence, Second Edition, a modern comprehensive text statement of American law – State and Federal – completely revised and rewritten in the light of modern authorities and developments.

The encyclopedia – contains over 400 separate titles on a broad range of legal topics which, taken together, systematically describe the entire field of American legal doctrine.

- Documents available for each title may include a summary, an outline, each individual section of text and a Table of Parallel References.

- Each title is updated annually and any supplementary materials are included as part of the document updated.

The ALR database – contains the full text of the annotations included in the Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth, and Federal Series of the ALR and the ALR Index, all published by West.

- The database is an online version of the American Law Reports. A document is an annotation or section of the index. The full text of example cases imprint ALR is not included.

The REST database – contains the complete text of the Restatements of the Law, various Tentative Drafts and Proposed Final Drafts of the Restatements of the Law, and Tentative Draft-related documents from The ALI Reporter

- A document is (1) a section of the Restatement First, Second, or Third; (2) a section of a Tentative or Proposed Final Draft; (3) a section of Tentative Draft-related material from The ALI Reporter; (4) a section of an Appendix, Cumulative Annual Pocket Part or Supplement; (5) an Interim Case Citations pamphlet containing citations and other references to a section of the Restatements of Law First, Second, Third; or (6) Tentative or Proposed Final Drafts.
